Our building is easily accessible with a flat entrance path and wide door to the front and ramp with wide doors to the rear.

We have a toilet and wash room which can accommodate a wheel chair and support rails are fitted.

When purchasing our play / learning equipment we take into consideration the needs of both boys and girls, differing abilities and needs. Our furniture, toilet facilities, play equipment storage units are child height.

Our policies and procedures are displayed on the office wall and copies are available in the policy folder and information for parents book. As part of their induction process they are explained to staff and reviewed at staff meetings. Staff have identified roles and responsibilities for specific areas. They are explained to parents at their initial visit before their child starts.

Partnership with parents has always been important to us and the staff acknowledge their roles as primary carers, something they understand as professionals and being parents themselves.

Our admissions policy admits any child who is the right age and no discrimination is ever applied. We value each child as a unique individual, we will motivate and encourage them in areas of weakness or disinterest and build on their strengths.

Our environment is warm and welcoming for parents and any visitors to Cabbage Patch. The children play and learn in a fun, caring atmosphere with staff they are happy, confident and secure to share their pre school years with.
