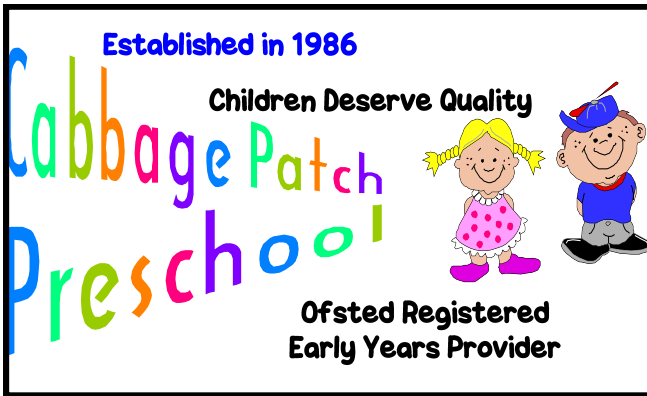


Cabbage Patch news June 2020

From week beginning 15th we will look at any playgroup stage children whose parents would like them to return and if any spaces are available we will offer them. Thank you for your understanding and the many lovely messages I have read or received verbally from parents.

We are not able to have our usual family fun and sports day or our toddle for Barnardo's. We are thinking of ways to have parties, graduations for our Preschool children and will send more information in July. We cannot make arrangements yet as guidance may change. We do want to make the end of term special particularly for the children leaving us for school.
